Guidelines

- 1. The 2024 MCMA Scholarship Competition Auditions will take place in person on **Sunday, May 12, 2024**. The audition schedule will be distributed to applicants via email no later than April 21, 2024.
- 2. All scholarships are processed as MCMA tuition credits (no cash value) and will be applied to the 2024-25 academic year for the discipline for which the scholarship was awarded.

Tuition credits must be applied to a full year (34-38 weeks) of individual instruction at the Conservatory for lessons on the instrument/discipline for which the scholarship was awarded.

All MCMA tuition scholarships are open to all music students. Scholarships must be applied to 2024 registration no later than June 30, 2024. If registration for lessons has not taken place by June 30, 2024, it will be assumed that the winner has declined the scholarship, and the scholarship will be awarded to the runner-up in that specific category.

- 3. Selections are not required to be memorized during the audition, but it is highly encouraged. Original copies of each selection must be available for the accompanist and adjudicator. Please mark the page of each selection for the adjudicator.
- 4. Letter grades will be assigned to each performance. Assessment is based upon outstanding performance in the audition, and awards are subject to the successful candidate achieving a minimum mark of A or better. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 5. Live accompanists are required for all scholarship categories with the exception of the *CanWest Global Jazz Scholarship**. Recorded accompaniment is not allowed.

- 6. Candidates must make their own arrangements for accompaniment, should one be required for their audition (voice, strings, winds/brass). The candidate is solely responsible for all accompanist fees. The MCMA can provide a list of accompanists at the request of the student, but details regarding rehearsals and payment will be arranged between the student and the accompanist.
- 7. Application deadline is April 8, 2024. Complete applications may be submitted in person at the MCMA office or to Joyce German by email (<u>info@mcma.ca</u>). Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- 8. Specialized Scholarship Requirements

a. CanWest Global Jazz Scholarship

One scholarship of \$250.00 will be awarded. Candidates must perform two contrasting jazz pieces for the audition. A candidate for this scholarship may also apply for an MCMA General Scholarship; however, repertoire may not be repeated from another category.

Applicants may use recorded accompaniment in this instance in lieu of a rhythm section. Tracks must be submitted (in .mp4 format) to info@mcma.ca before April 8, 2024.

b. Sydney McInnis Baroque Scholarship

One scholarship of \$200.00 will be awarded. Candidates must perform two contrasting selections from the Baroque Era, each from separate works. A candidate for this scholarship may also apply for an MCMA General Scholarship, however, repertoire may not be repeated in either audition.

c. MCMA Musical Theatre Scholarship

One scholarship of \$200.00 will be awarded. Candidates must perform two contrasting selections from the musical theatre canon, each from separate works. A candidate for this scholarship may also apply for an MCMA General Voice Scholarship; however, repertoire may not be repeated in either audition.
